

Rigi Scholarship for bachelor's and master's students

A solid education is the best way to launch a successful professional career. But studying is expensive and not everybody has the necessary financial means or support. The Rigi Scholarship is funded through the earmarked donation of a charitable Swiss foundation.

Target group

Prospective or current bachelor's or master's students at the HSLU's Schools of Engineering and Architecture, Business, Social Work, Design, Film and Art, and Computer Science and Information Technology. The scholarship is exclusively for

- Swiss nationals and non-citizens with at least ten years of permanent residence in Switzerland
- who can prove that they do not have the financial means or support from their family to bear the costs of studying for a bachelor's or master's degree at the HSLU.

Application and evaluation process

An application is valid if all the documents specified in the application form are submitted within the published deadline. The scholarship panel will invite suitable candidates for a short in-person interview in Lucerne. The panel will ask for an annual update on the recipient's financial situation and decide on the continuation of the payments based on the information supplied.

Scholarship amount

Typically, the scholarship amounts to CHF 5,000 per semester. Half-scholarships are available as well. The scholarship can be extended for up to six semesters or until the bachelor's or master's programme is completed. The scholarship amount will be wired to the applicant's Swiss bank or postal account at the beginning of the semester.

Conditions

By accepting the scholarship, the recipient commits to

- studying with above-average motivation.
- submitting an annual update on the application documents.
- immediately notifying the HSLU Foundation if he or she suspends or terminates his or her studies.
- publicly referencing the HSLU's Rigi Scholarship if he or she wins an award or prize while enrolled in, or graduating from, a degree programme at the HSLU.
- making him- or herself available for marketing and promotional publications upon prior notice.
- participating in events associated with the Rigi Scholarship.

The HSLU Foundation reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the scholarship offer upon the scholarship panel's recommendation, if a recipient

- fails to honour the commitments listed above.
- suspends or terminates his or her studies.

In either case, the recipient is obliged to return the last semester payment received. The scholarship panel can waive this requirement in cases of hardship.

Decisions on the award of scholarships are not subject to legal appeal.
