Abstract

Stakeholders' sensitiveness towards sustainability issues has resulted in increasing their expectations towards corporate social responsibility (CSR). Indeed, it has been acknowledged that companies play a key role in promoting a model of development that is sustainable for both the environment and the people living in it. After carrying out a qualitative analysis based on primary and secondary data, the research highlighted that the focus topics at the core of Perlen's Packaging CSR strategy are human and labour rights, environmental protection and responsible sourcing. On the other hand, the major expectation identified by stakeholders is for the company to develop a long-term social and environmental sustainability strategy that may satisfy clients, suppliers and employees needs.
